The Government of Canada would like to inform you that based on your family income, **(Insert child's first name)** qualifies to receive a **\$500 Canada Learning Bond** for education after high school. Once you apply, the Canada Learning Bond will be deposited directly into your child's Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP).

In addition to the first \$500, **(Insert child's first name)** can get an extra \$100 per year, up to the age of 15, as long as you continue to receive the **National Child Benefit Supplement**. Over time, the **Canada Learning Bond** could add up to \$2,000. It's that simple!

This money can be used for full-time or part-time studies toward an education after high school such as a trade school, CEGEP, college or university. **In fact, you don't even have to put any of your own money into the RESP to get the Canada Learning Bond for your child.**

Because **(Insert child's first name)** already has an RESP, you simply have to:

1. Contact your financial institution to apply for the Canada Learning Bond; or
2. If someone else has opened the RESP for your child, you can ask that person to apply for the Canada Learning Bond.
